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In accordance with the Internal Regulation of CU No. 23/2008 Directive of the Rector of Comenius University Bratislava regulating the conditions for concluding contracts in connection with the study of foreign students at Comenius University Bratislava, in accordance with Art. 22(2)(j) of the Statute of JFMED CU in Martin and after discussion in the Management Board of the Jessenius Faculty of Medicine of CU in Martin (hereinafter referred to as

"JFMED CU") on 1 March 2017

I issue

this Internal Regulation on payment conditions for students studying in English (hereinafter referred to as "the Student") at JFMED CU in Martin.

Art. 1 Mechanism for payment of tuition and fees

- 1. The Student is obliged to pay for each year of study provided under the contract/decision an annual tuition fee in the amount specified in the internal regulation of CU, which determines the amount of tuition fees and fees associated with study at Comenius University Bratislava for the relevant academic year, unless the contract between the Student and JFMED CU provides otherwise.
- 2. The Student is obliged to pay a fee for material support of the admission procedure in the amount determined by the internal regulation of the CU and JFMED CU for the given academic year.
- 3. The Student pays the annual tuition fee and the fee for the material support of the admission procedure for the respective academic year always in advance, at the latest on the day of enrolment by wire transfer to the bank account of JFMED CU. Proof of payment of tuition fees shall be presented by the Student on the day of enrolment at the Study Department of the Faculty. If the Student fails to comply with the obligation under Section 71(3)(b) of the Higher Education Act, as amended, he/she ceases to be a student. The payment instruction regarding payments is set out in the Annex to this Directive.
- 4. The Student can pay the annual tuition fee in two instalments:
 - a) the first instalment the tuition fee for the winter semester of the academic year at the latest on the day of enrolment in the respective year of study;
 - b) the second instalment the tuition fee for the summer semester of the academic year at the latest on the first day of the teaching period of the summer semester of the academic year.

Proof of payment of tuition fees (first and second instalments) shall be submitted by the Student to the Study Department, which will include it in the personal file.

- 5. In the event that a Student defaults in the payment of tuition and fees by the deadlines set forth in paragraph 4 of this Directive, the Students shall not be permitted to attend classes.
- 6. If the Student fails to pay the arrears of tuition and fees by the deadline specified in the notice pursuant to paragraph 5 of this Directive, he/she will be excluded from his/her studies.



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Art. 2 Tuition and Fee Refund Policy

- 1. In the event of termination of studies pursuant to Section 66 of the Higher Education Act, the Faculty is not obliged to refund tuition and fees already paid for the current semester of the academic year in which the Student terminated his/her studies.
- 2. If the Student has been admitted as part of the admission procedure and has previously studied at the Faculty of Medicine, has applied for recognition of the completed courses and, in accordance with Art. 31 of the Study Regulations of JFMED CU, the courses and credits taken have been recognised for him/her, he/she will be charged with the annual tuition fee in the amount specified in the internal regulation of the CU for the given academic year.

Art. 3 Final provisions

- 1. Upon this Internal Regulation becoming effective, VP No. 40/2016 Directive on the payment conditions of students studying in English at JFMED CU is repealed.
- 2. This Internal Regulation shall enter into force and become effective on 1 March 2017.
