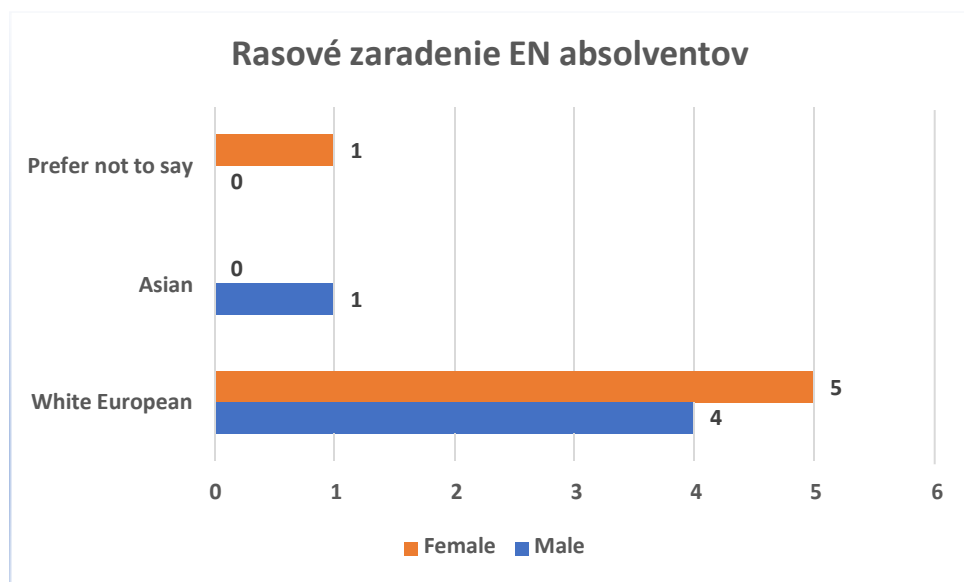

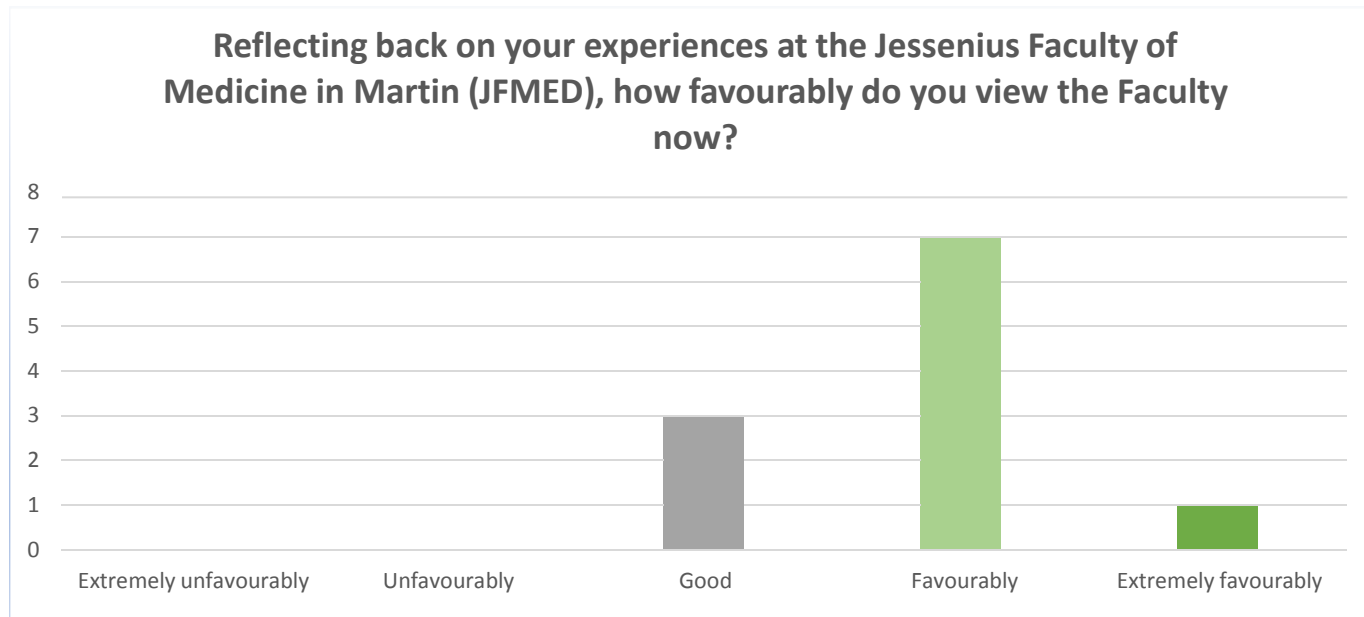

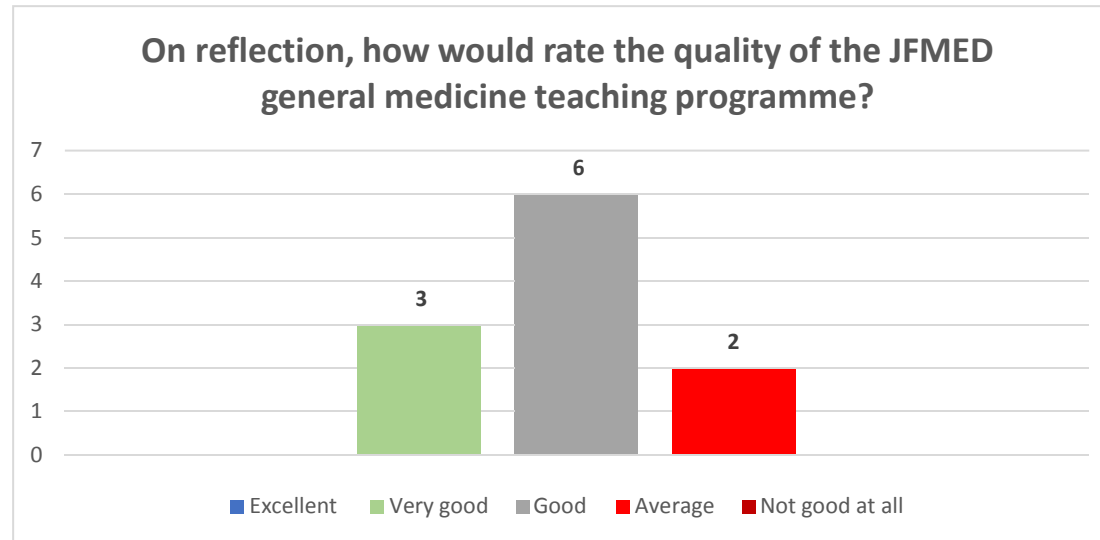

Good:

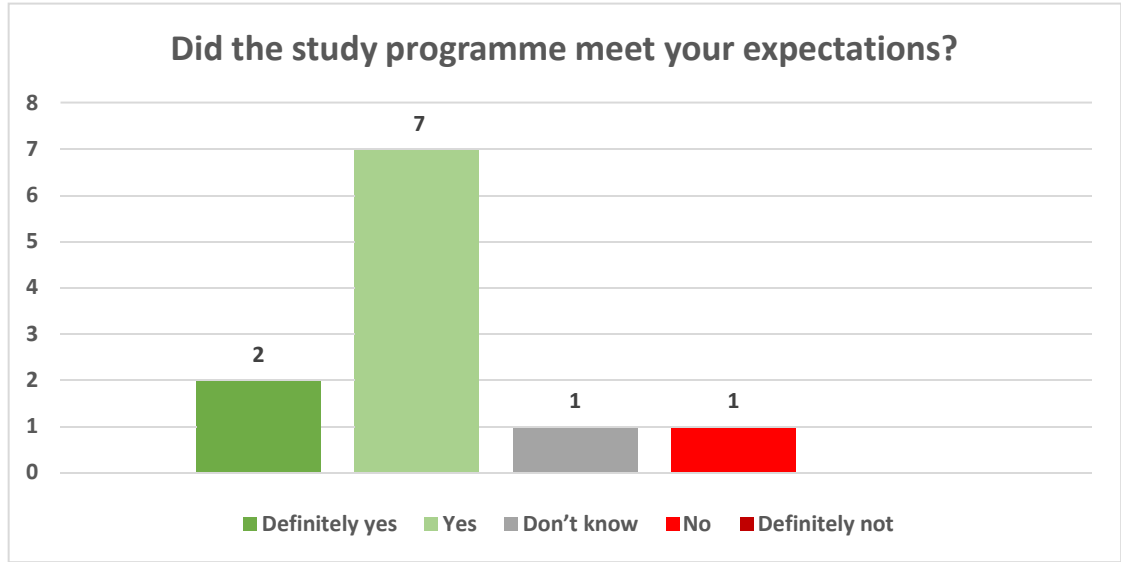

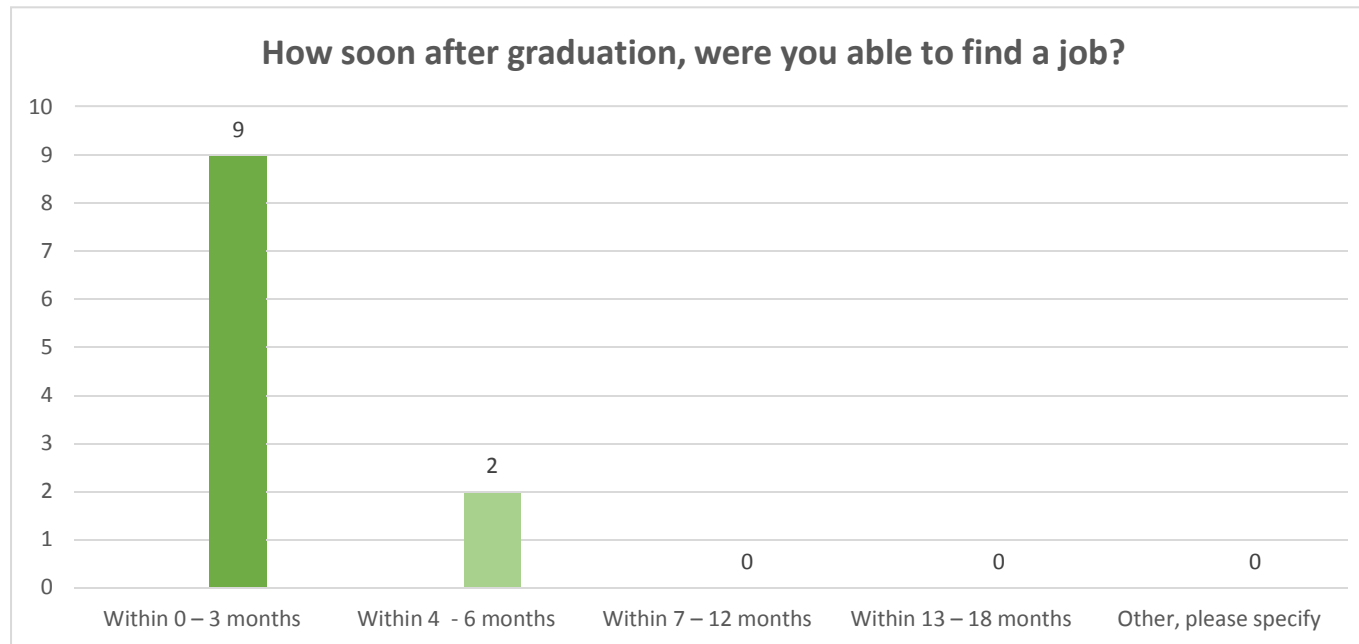
Comments (WHY?)

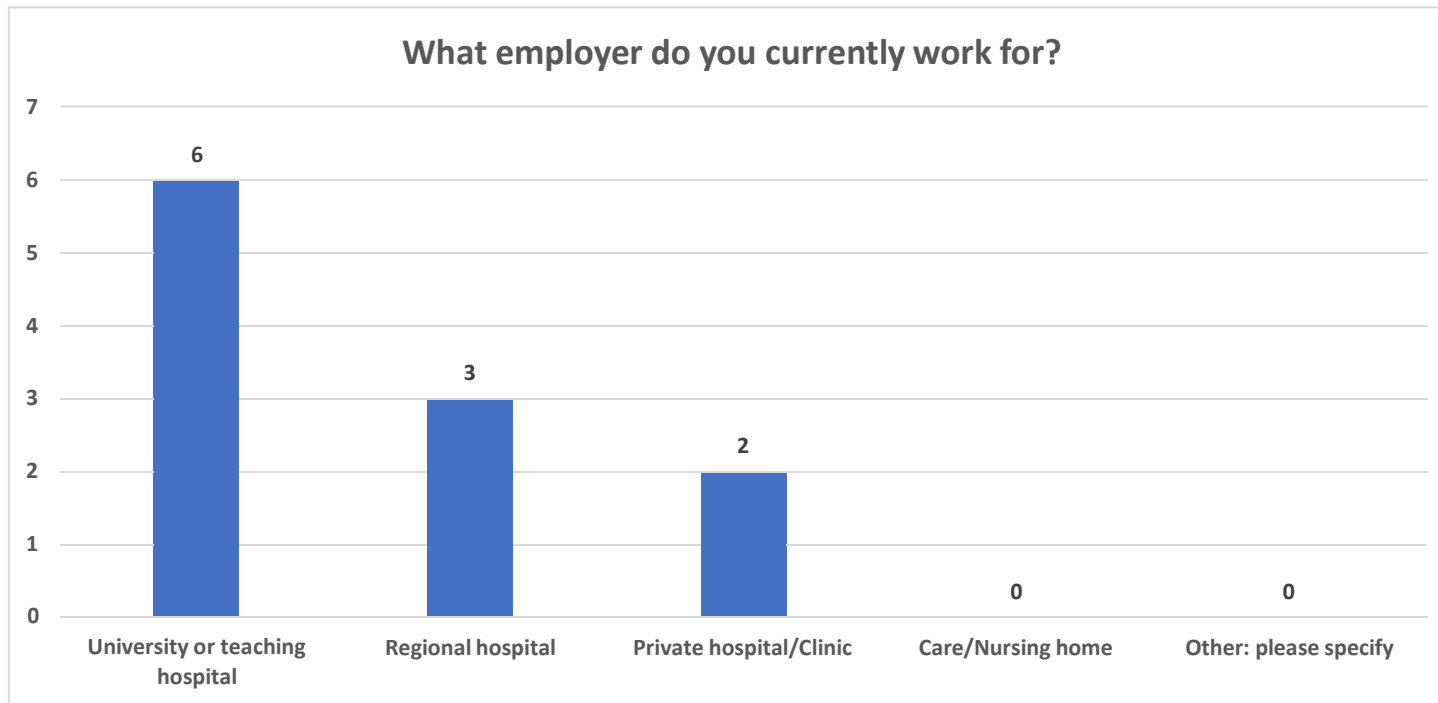
