3. Employability

- a) Evaluation of the study programme graduate's employability.

Pursuant to Section 68 of the Act on Higher Education Institutions (131/2002), JFM CU issues documents on the completion of a study program. Evidence of the necessary qualifications for the exercise of the profession and the acquisition of the relevant academic degree are a university diploma, a diploma supplement and a state examination certificate. Evidence of completion of studies is issued within 45 days of the proper completion of studies, usually at the graduation ceremony, unless the graduate agrees to the later issuance of documents no later than on the day of fulfilment of the last condition for graduation.

The study program Public Health at the JFM CU is implemented in accordance with the relevant provisions of Government Regulation 296/2010 on professional competence to perform the medical profession, the method of further education of medical staff, the system of specialized disciplines and the system of certified work activities.

Theoretical and practical knowledge of graduates gained during the study are based on principles of Public Health, Evidence Based Public Health (EBPH), Evidence Based Medicine (EBM), Evidence Based Practice (EBP) and make possible them to employ the latest pieces of knowledge in their profession. EBPH, EBM and EBP make possible them to understand expert issues considering the latest pieces of knowledge and not just to master the principles. Each issue present different principle and approach based on scholar information. The graduate of the study program is generally educated and is able to integrate theoretical knowledge on medical and public health disciplines with other biomedical and social sciences, to transform them into a holistic approach in the practice of the public health worker. The study program ensures high-quality employment of graduates at home and abroad. Based on graduate feedback as well as a survey by the Ministry of Labour, Social Affairs and Family, 100% of graduates of the study program are employed

The study program was created in accordance with the needs of practice; therefore, one of the main aspects in the design of subjects was the aspect of applicability of knowledge and competencies in real practice.

In terms of strategic goals in the field of international activities (page 12 of the project), the program and its study plan were designed so that students can complete part of their studies abroad while studying this study program, in which the faculty has extensive experience and a wide network of partner universities with related study programs for the submitted study program.

The proposal is in accordance with Decree No. 614/2002 Coll. on the study credit system and Act No. 131/2002 Coll. on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments to Certain Acts.

The recommended study plan keeps assigned workload expressed as number of hours of contact teaching together with all activities needed for preparation and completion of the courses. Number of credits for the individual courses were assigned to consider demandingness of the course considering specific field of learned issues and ways of successful completing. The courses within the recommended study plan make possible to reach assigned outcomes of the education.

The amount of credits for bachelor state exam is 10 credits and for the Defence of Bachelor Thesis is 4 credits. The courses of the state exams are part of the study plan and the credits obtained for these subjects are added to the student only after their successful completion.

- f) *The institution describes the rules for verification of learning outcomes, students' assessment and the possibilities of appealing against the assessment.*

The individual methods of evaluation of study results are designed to clearly determine and verify the required conditions for passing the course. The student is acquainted in time with the dates of regular and corrective possibilities of continuous assessment and with regular and corrective dates of exams. Every student has the right to be informed about the evaluation of all parts of the continuous assessment and examination. The student has the right not to accept the evaluation on the exam date and to register for the relevant corrective exam date. If a student has been assessed with the FX grade at the regular exam date or has not applied for one of the regular exam dates in time, he / she is entitled to two corrective exam dates. The student has the right to request the completion of any exam date by a "commission form" of examination. The Dean, on the proposal of the person with the main responsibility for the implementation, development and quality assurance of the study program, appoints at least a three-member examination commission; the chairman of the examination commission is usually the teacher of the given subject. The commission form of the examination can take place without the student's request, if requested by the subject teacher. Details are regulated by the Study Regulations of the JFM CU in Art. 11 Evaluation of study results (IR JFM CU No. 13/2020).

The student may apply for review of the decision on expulsion from the study. The Dean may grant the request or forward the request within 15 days from the date of its delivery to the Rector, together with the attached file material and a written opinion on the applicant's statements and objections. At the written request of the student, the Dean may grant an exemption from the terms of the faculty study schedule, from the control stages of the study, from the maximum length of study interruption, allow the study to be interrupted if the student does not meet the conditions of the control phase or waive. 8. Spatial, material, and technical provision of the study programme and support

a) List and characteristics of the study programme classrooms and their technical equipment with the assignment to learning outcomes and courses (laboratories, design and art studios, studios, workshops, interpreting booths, clinics, priest seminaries, science and technology parks, technology incubators, school enterprises, practice centers, training schools, classroom-training facilities, sports halls, swimming pools, sports grounds).

All JFM CU facilities are well-arranged for high-quality teaching-learning process as well as for conducting scientific research activities. A significant stimulus for the modernization of the existing JFM CU infrastructure was the successful implementation of projects co-financed by the Structural Funds. All theoretical (basic sciences), preclinical, and clinical workplaces have modern instrumentation, technical and material equipment. The accessible infrastructure makes it possible to obtain original results and provide modern educational, as well as scientific research activities for students and academic staff. Well-equipped JFM CU infrastructure include, among others, modern communication technologies, audio-visual devices, and didactic equipment for learning. The JFM CU continues to develop IT technology by ensuring the widespread availability of the Internet for students and building a system of videoconferencing with the possibility of demonstrating medical interventions, including real-time surgery. In addition, specialized classrooms are furnished with education materials and accessories.

Educational and scientific research activities are carried out in the following medical facilities: Malá Hora 4, Malá Hora 4B, Malá Hora 4C, Malá Hora 4D and Malá Hora 5, Biomedical Centre Martin (BioMed Martin) and Facilities for non-medical study programs (Midwifery, Public Health, and Nursing). Clinical subjects and practice are dominantly provided in the University Hospital Martin. The majority of the Faculty facilities are located within the area of Malá Hora. This integral complex of facilities provides wide spectrum of opportunities for both educational a research activities and interdisciplinary cooperation.

Educational activities and scientific sessions at JFMED take place at following locations: two lecture halls nearby the student dormitory, lecture hall at Mala Hora 4, lecture hall at Mala Hora 5, lecture hall in the Education Center in Mala Hora 4B, and two lecture halls at the University Martin Hospital. Since 2010, JFMED also has its own modern hall with a capacity of 476 seats. In addition, modern interactive education is provided and supported by Academic Information Center (since 2012) which also includes the Simulation Learning Center (currently called the Medical Education Support Center). This workplace is currently significantly expanded and strengthens its equipment, as well as staff capacity to ensure the teaching and training of skills. In addition to abovementioned major education sites, every department use their own teaching rooms with relevant technical and multimedia support (Wifi connectivity, Interactive screens and whiteboards, personal computers, etc).

In addition to educational activities, the faculty is also intensively involved in the development of scientific research activities, including the activities of students. Facilities which are directly involved in research include Biomedical Centre Martin, the Center for Translational Medicine, the Center for Experimental and Clinical Respiriology and the Center of Excellence for Perinatalogical Research. - b) Characteristics of the study programme information management (access to study literature according to Course information sheets, access to information databases and other information sources, information technologies, etc.).

Information delivery (library and information services) and access to study literature: The Academic Library and Audiovisual Center of the JFM CU is a scientific-information, bibliographic, coordination and counselling workplace. The library provides library-related service in all study programs. Through its activities, it provides support for studies and education at the faculty, as well as scientific research activities. It provides services in accordance with the Library and Lending Regulations of the Library. It also follows the methodological guidelines and instructions of the Academic Library of Comenius University (CU), the instructions and methodologies of the Center for Scientific and Technical Information of the Slovak Republic, and internal regulations of the JFM CU dean. As part of the information provision of study fields, it provides students with library and information services in order to meet the educational, scientific-research, social and cultural needs of:

- Lending services - attendance and interlibrary services
- Access to the online catalogue - building and access to the comprehensive online catalogue of the CU. Access to the library collection is via the CU online catalogue and via the JFM CU library website: <http://alis.uniba.sk:8088/search/query?locale=en&theme=Katalog>

- Special services - search services from own library funds
- Purchase of a library fund (acquisition) - special attention is paid to supplementing the basic and recommended study literature. The active participation of users is also used and based on their proposals, the purchase of professional medical literature is carried out. The JFM CU fund consists of specialized medical literature for the study programs: general medicine, dentistry and non-medical study program. The fund consists of sets of scientific medical material (scientific journals, books, textbooks, etc.)
- Bibliographic registration and storage of PhD. and diploma theses - access to information
- Publication database - access to the online catalogue of publication activities: <http://alis.uniba.sk:9909/search/query?locale=en&theme=EPC>. Publishing activity is registered online through a nationwide database CREPČ2 (central register of publication evidence). The CREPČ2 database records bibliographic records such as publications and citations. The database allows independence from library formats, social rights and rules for users, as well as internal control in the creation of entities and records at all universities in Slovakia. At present, the academic library provides access to the information provision of study programs on the basis of library and information processes, which are fully automated through the VIRTUA library information system and the CREPČ2 register.

Access to information databases and other information resources: The Academic Library provides access to licensed electronic information resources (EIR) which are made available within the NISPEZ project. Access to EIR is possible via computers connected to the JFM CU network or via remote access to CU information resources also from computers connected outside the CU network. Faculty library offers the services of a digital study room, which is equipped with computers with internet access, access to CU catalogs, and electronic information sources. Students have access to the study rooms daily and on weekends and public holidays from 7.00 am until 10.00 pm. Information technologies at the JFM CU: JFM CU utilize for its activities information and communication technologies (ICT) focused on administrative tasks, operations, science and research, study, teaching support, testing, e-learning and video conferencing, web presentation, user support, digitization, printing, and survey forms processing. ICT also cover purchase and repair of hardware and software, operation, management and monitoring of computer networks, data centers, user terminals, access control systems, and security and camera systems. Department of information technology cooperates with the Center for Information Technologies of the CU. Information systems services: E-mail and Office365 – all JFM CU employees and students with mailbox capacity of 50 GB. Office365 is a cloud service provided by the Microsoft Corporation. It offers e-mail, calendar, communication tools and online version of office package Office. Thanks to Office365 account, students and teachers have an opportunity to download and use supplement services of Microsoft, such as download and install the Office package. The address is in the form *univerzitnylogin@uniba.sk*. For employees also in the form *name.surname@uniba.sk*, *name.lastname@jfmed.uniba.sk* and *surname@jfmed.uniba.sk*. The address and mailbox will

remain with them even after the end of employment or study. The official e-mail communication of the university, messages from the AIS system or from the university's e-learning system are delivered to this mailbox. Information on how to access the mailbox or how to redirect it to another address can be found at <https://moja.uniba.sk/?lang=en> (University E-mail Office 365). Automatic and optimized mailing lists and groups are created for the purpose of mass mailing to department heads, teachers, researchers, PhD students and students. In addition to e-mail, other services are available that simplify document handling and support group collaboration such as SharePoint for file sharing within the UC, OneDrive - 5TB document cloud storage per user, MS Teams for distance learning and online communication, Office 365 online (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Access, etc.), and Office 365 offline.

Faculty website: The website <https://www.ifmed.uniba.sk/en/> uses the university-wide CMS Typo3 to create the faculty's website and its workplaces. Each workplace has a web editor who updates the relevant pages online. JFM CU was the first faculty of CU to use a new web interface. Department of information technology participates in the technical implementation and administration of websites for feedback, surveys and conferences organized by individual departments of the faculty. c) Characteristics and extent of distance education applied in the study programme with the assignment to courses. Access, manuals of e-learning portals. Procedures for the transition from contact teaching to distance learning.

The JFM CU has been paying special attention to the issue of e-learning for a long time. During the COVID-19 pandemic the teaching has been delivered remotely. The activities of the JFM CU in the field of e-learning are divided into the following areas:

- Electronic creation and distribution of teaching materials
- Videoconferences: <https://www.ifmed.uniba.sk/en/departments/information-workplaces/department-of-information-technology/it-services/videoconferences/>; <https://www.ifmed.uniba.sk/distance-vzdelavanie/>;
- Distance education: We also use the above technique in the organization of webinars <https://webinarlfuk.sk>

Videoconferencing systems are used for online live transmissions of surgeries to the auditorium for students, doctors and PhD students within the e-learning education system. The use of videoconferencing equipment enables the online transmission of demanding surgical interventions to the premises where professional events and teaching take place. The faculty also has a new Cisco Telepresence facility. These devices are used not only for e-learning, but also for the transmission of training and video conferencing meetings with the CU management. The transfer of training and meetings has a direct economic benefit in reducing the need to traveling to Bratislava. The videoconferencing system was expanded with a new state-of-the-art TP20 Cisco IX5000 device at the JFM CU Dean's Office. Telepresence room serves for effective and multipurpose communication <https://www.tp.cvtisr.sk/>. It is also used for online transmissions of trainings and meetings from RUK in Bratislava and for connections via other video conferencing programs - such as a display unit for Skype, Google Meet, Zoom, Microsoft Teams and others - thus providing comfortable communication thanks to three large screens. It also proved successful in connections within domestic and international scientific conferences and especially in state examinations carried out in the distance form, which had to be carried out in connection with security measures associated with the worsened epidemiological situation (coronavirus COVID-19). All videoconferencing facilities are used to increase the quality of education, intensify national and international cooperation and communication with the world, online mediation of conferences, special diagnostic and therapeutic procedures with the possibility of consultations. The faculty also has a unique 3D video conferencing system.

Distance education (including distance exams) is implemented at the faculty mainly through the Microsoft Teams program. In cooperation with CU, a manual was developed, which is published on the faculty website

<https://www.ifmed.uniba.sk/en/departments/information-workplaces/department-of-information-technology/it-services/online-komunikacia>. Department of information technology provide 24/7 technical support. Distance learning is constantly being improved and enriched with new elements by connecting software and hardware (connecting an electron microscope or ultrasound to live online learning via Microsoft Teams). We also use the above technique in the organization of webinars <https://webinarlfuk.sk>. To improve distance learning, the faculty also uses a digitization. This offers the ability to digitize existing X-rays and other medical images into the full medical DICOM format, and subsequent processing on the HIPAX desktop system. Digitized images are stored on an external medium, burned to a CD / DVD, or transferred to another PACS system. In addition, the faculty has the possibility of large format printing and scanning - printing posters in high quality in A0 format. The faculty has at its disposal a high-capacity device (Book Digitizer and Script ScanRobot TREVENTUS) enabling digitization of books and scripts in cooperation with OCR software and publishing on the web using FlipViewer Xpress Creator. At present, narrow-profile publications, which are of the greatest interest among students in the library, are being digitized. The Electronic Books Portal system and Adobe Connect are intended for the distribution of digitized materials.

E-learning web portals: The Faculty is a founding member of the MEFANET network (association of Czech and other Slovak medical faculties <https://www.mefanet.cz/index-en.php>). The MEFANET portal at the JFM CU has more than 2,450 registered users and contains more than 445 medical articles. The faculty portal <https://portal.ifmed.uniba.sk/index-en.php> is integrated into the MEFANET system. The content of the pedagogical works is published in a form that corresponds to the scripts published in print (most often in PDF format). Works recognized by the editorial board of JLF UK are marked with the logo on the portal. Furthermore, the content of the portal includes multimedia teaching aids, which are either physically located on the JFM CU portal, or there is a link to them. Teachers

can also make sound lectures available to their students <https://portal.ifmed.uniba.sk/index-en.php>. The pedagogical staff and students of the faculty use the e-learning server MOODLE to create e-learning courses and online testing. Some e-learning courses are used for electronic online testing of students, but there are also comprehensive courses that students can use for self-study. For users of e-learning systems, the e-learning portal JFM CU was created <https://e-learning.ifmed.uniba.sk/en-index.php>, which contains, among other things, manuals for individual e-learning web portals. To support teaching, various teaching websites, portals, web multimedia textbooks, e-books are also being created at our faculty. The above services are concentrated and available from the unified distance education portal. The portal is divided into six sections: e-learning, e-testing, external information sources, online communication, publishing platforms, online simulation simulators and virtual patients. Each of these sections contains a list of available software, a brief description of what each software allows, available links, manuals, tutorials, FAQs and, of course, the contact person to support the software.

- d) Institution partners in providing educational activities for the study programme and the characteristics of their participation. The main specialised teaching facilities include: Regional Public Health Authority in Martin, and University Hospital in Martin. ŽILPO s. r. o. Žilina is another specialised teaching place. Practical education and summer practice are realised at the Regional Public Health Authority in Martin. In a frame of clinical disciplines the teaching is provided in clinics and departments of the University Hospital in Martin. Required summer practice is arranged through indefinite period agreements with healthcare facilities according to students' preferences and guarantees recommendations. The Faculty has signed memorandum of understanding and cooperation in science, pedagogics and medical-preventive care with Žilina Region (https://www.ifmed.uniba.sk/detail-novinky/back_to_page/jesseniova-lekarska-fakulta-uk/article/podpisali-sme-so-zsk-novu-spolupracu-v-oblasti-zdravotnictva/).
- e) Characteristics of the possibilities for social, sports, cultural, spiritual and social activities. The Faculty offers a wide range of activities and services to students. The Faculty runs two student residences with the capacity of 958 beds. The residence on L. Novomeského street (capacity 781 beds) and the residence on P. O. Hviezdoslavova street (capacity 177 beds) offer accommodation in the style of hotel rooms (double and triple occupancy), apartments and en-suite apartments. All rooms are furnished and have access to Wifi. Both residences also offer laundry facilities and secure bike lockers. There are two parking slots on the compound of L. Novomeského and, nearby, there is a student library with fully equipped study rooms (<https://www.ifmed.uniba.sk/akas/>). Within this residence, there are also two table tennis game rooms, two fitness rooms and two leisure rooms. Outside, there is a sport complex with a running track, a football pitch and tennis courts. The canteen at the L. Novomeského is operational throughout the day, offering breakfasts, lunches and dinners to staff and students. The canteen offers a reduced service during the summer and exam period months. This residence also has a chapel (<https://www.ifmed.uniba.sk/pracoviska/ucelove-pracoviska/vysokoskolsky-internat-a-jedalen/stravovanie/>). The JFM CU Institute of Physical Education is nearby both residences and further offers sport and wellness facilities (<https://www.ifmed.uniba.sk/pracoviska/vedecko-pedagogicke-pracoviska/teoreticke-ustavy/ustav-telesnej-vychovy/novinky/>). JFM CU students are also organized in groups such as the Martin Medical Club that covers a range of activities in specialisms such as public health, development of medical science, scientific and research activities but also looks at areas such as human rights (<https://www.ifmed.uniba.sk/martinsky-klub-medikov/>). Group and charitable events such as the Festival of Medics, The Medics run, ice-hockey tournament called the Martin Stethoscope, MedGames and many more are organized by students every year. Students also take part in international events and competitions and sit on the councils and boards of national and international organizations such as the National Association of Medical Students, The Slovakian Union of Dentistry Students and the International Federation of Medical Students. Moreover, organization committee of the Student Scientific and Professional Activities works at the Faculty coordinating work of interns within undergraduate students and organizes each year the Student Scientific Conference (<https://www.ifmed.uniba.sk/veda/studentstva/vedecka-cinnost-svoc/>).
- f) Possibilities and conditions for participation of the study programme students in mobilities and internships (indicating contact details), application instructions, rules for recognition of this education. The Faculty is involved in the Erasmus + initiative and offers the following mobility programs: Erasmus + student mobility – available to all students across the general medicine and nursing study programs. This type of mobility is based on an inter-institutional agreement with partner universities (https://www.ifmed.uniba.sk/fileadmin/jlf/Dekanat/referat-zahranicnych-vztahov/Erasmus_ERASMUS2022/BA_Erasmus_Januar_26.pdf) and the length of stay is between a minimum of three and a maximum of 12 months. Various conditions are attached to student mobility, including:
- Students are unable to interrupt their studies during their Erasmus stay
 - Students must complete and agree a Learning agreement with their home and hosting university
 - Students can only apply for Erasmus places with universities that have inter-institutional agreement with JFMED.
- The application process for the Erasmus + student mobility is open twice a year and is submitted via the Mobility Online platform.

Student mobility for Traineeship

Students can join the traineeship mobility at any state of their studies [BA, MA or PhD level] for a minimum of two and a maximum of 12 months. With this type of mobility, the onus on student to find a suitable placement and secure a place. If the content of placement is aligned with the student's study plan, it will be automatically recognized and added to the Diploma supplement document.

Application process

The JFM CU Erasmus Office will announce the start date for submitting the applications. The applications are submitted via the Mobility Online platform and can be submitted throughout the year. Students can submit their application as soon as their placement at the hosting institution is confirmed.

Erasmus + mobility for graduates

JFM CU students can also apply for Erasmus + mobility for graduates, once they have completed their studies. This type of mobility is financed by the EU from Erasmus + program grants and lasts a minimum of two and a maximum of 12 months. This mobility is delivered in partnership with WorkSpace Europe (www.workspaceeurope.sk) and can be completed within the 12 month-period after graduating. Contacts

9. Required abilities and admission requirements for the study programme applicants

a) Required abilities and necessary admission requirements.

Completing of full secondary education or full professional secondary education and in regulated professions also health eligibility for performing a profession are fundamental conditions for admission for full-time bachelor study.

Another condition for admission for bachelor study is a position in a list of applicants ranked ascending according to average of marks in year-end school reports during last three years of study in a secondary school up number of maximum planned students for the respective study program. The JFM CU reserves right to waive fulfilment of the other condition for admission in reasoned situations.

Condition for admission are annually approved by the Academic Senate JFM CU in accordance with the Act. No. 131/2022 Coll. and Internal Regulation of the Comenius University No. 4/2021 (https://uniba.sk/fileadmin/ruk/legislativa/2021/Vp_2021_04.pdf) and Internal Regulation of the JFM CU No. 23/2021

10. Feedback on the quality of provided education

a) Procedures for monitoring and evaluating students' opinions on the study programme quality.

The student feedback is processed at regular intervals and discussed at various management and committee meetings.

b) Results of student feedback and related measures to improve the study programme quality.

The student feedback results – the assessment of teachers and subjects – are collated after each semester and the summarized report is shared with every head of the clinic/department and/or the subject guarantee with the view to incorporate the comment into improving the quality of teaching and subjects.
