



## General information

## Teaching

## Crossing the border and travel information

When entering the territory of the Slovak Republic, you will need to present a **negative Covid-19 test** no older than seven days. **If you are unable to provide a negative test, you will need to self-isolate for 14 days.** Those without permanent residence in Slovakia can self-isolate in selected hotels and other appropriate accommodations (subject to fees and charges).

## Vaccination

Vaccination against Covid-19 is now [opened](#) to everyone who is 12 years of age and older. There are different types of vaccines offered and more information will be provided at the time of making your booking.

If you are a foreign national, you will need to show valid proof of health insurance in Slovakia. The **EU citizens** will need to have E106 certificate or a [European Health Card](#). You will also be asked to show your [residence permit card](#).

Nationals from **outside the EU** will need to have health insurance with one of the following providers: [Union](#), [Dôvera](#) or [VŠZP](#). You will also be asked to show your [residence permit card](#).

**Please note that travel insurance is not accepted as valid means of insurance for vaccination.**

## International vaccination certificate

Anybody receiving a vaccine in Slovakia will now be issued with an international vaccination certificate. Those who have completed the full vaccination before June can now request the international vaccination certificate online at <https://vakcinacia.nczisk.sk/certifikat>. This process is fully automated and the international certificate will be sent to you by email.
