

Final Evaluation for Semester

To obtain credit from surgery is provided :

- **80 % participation in practical exercises** (20 % excused absence - 3 practical)
- **80 % attendance at lectures** (20 % excused absence - 3 lectures)
- **60 % success rate in test** of knowledge in the 7th and 13th week

Note:

Students must attend **80 % of practical exercises**. In the event that comply with the condition, has the option to substitute a **maximum of two practical in week 14**.

Students must pass the **test in the 7th week with the score of at least 60 %**. If they fail and get Fx, they are entitled to **2 corrective terms in week 14**.

Students must pass the **test in 13th week with the score of at least 60 %**. If they fail and get Fx, they are entitled to **2 corrective terms in week 14**.

If the semester finished with examination (3rd year winter semester), students must meet all the following conditions to be admitted to the exam and the final evaluation will receive **on the day of an exam**.

If the semester is not finished with exam students must meet all the following conditions and the student is evaluated at the end of the semester **from average grade of 2 mandatory tests**.

Evaluating scale:

According to art. 23 and art. 24 Study Regulations JLF UK, each subject is evaluated according to the following scale:

TEST 1

- A = 95-100% = 19-20 points
- B = 85- 90% = 17-18 points
- C = 75- 80% = 15-16 points
- D = 65- 70% = 13-14 points
- E = 60% = 12 points
- Fx = less than 60 % = less than 12 points

TEST 2

- A = 95 % -100 = 19-20 points
- B = 85-90 % = 17-18 points
- C = 75-80 % = 15-16 points
- D = 65-70 % = 13-14 points
- E = 60 % = 12 points
- Fx = less than 60 % = less than 12 points.

- A = 38-40 points
- B = 34-37 points
- C = 30-33 points
- D = 26-29 points
- E = 24-25 points
- Fx = less than 24 points
