

**Organization of Physiology 2**  
**for distance learning**  
**summer term, academic year 2020/2021**

1. Student actively participates in **93 % of all online practical sessions**; it is possible to miss one practical session without the need to replace it. The student participates in online practical exercises on the day given by the schedule. If student is unable to attend online practical on a given day, he/she will replace it in the 14th week of the summer term.
2. During the online teaching, the student must be present during the whole session. The presence control (attendance list) is done at the beginning and in the end of the online practical session. The student should connect from a quiet place/room with no disturbing influences. During the practical exercise, the camera and microphone has to be turned on.
3. The student prepares for practical exercise and participates with a necessary amount of theoretical knowledge which is checked by the teacher asking a questions of randomly selected students. The student gains theoretical knowledge from lectures and from the textbooks: Ganong, Guyton and tasks for practical sessions (Javorka et al.: Medical Physiology, laboratory manual).
4. The student prepares one power-point presentation according to the topic of practical sessions. The presentation is submitted by the student no later than one day before his/her practical exercise to the common page of MS Teams. Upon agreement with the teacher, maximum of 2 presentations can be given during online practical. The quality of each submitted presentation is assessed by the teacher, and the student can be requested to revise it. If the student does not manage to prepare the chosen topic during the term, he/she will choose a new topic after consultation with the teacher.
5. In the case of more than 20 % of missing practical session the permission on replacement is in the competence of the guarantee of the subject.
6. Student successfully passes all three **credit tests** (limit: 60% of correct answers):
  - Physiology of Respiratory system (5<sup>th</sup> week)
  - Physiology of Gastrointestinal system, metabolism and nutrition (7<sup>th</sup> week)
  - Physiology of Muscles, senses and nervous system (13<sup>th</sup> week)

**Successful passing through final exam**

The final examination is done in the exam period. The student can apply to the final exam after successful passing through the prerequisite Physiology 1, all practical sessions and all credit tests during Physiology 2.

**The form of the final exam depends on the current epidemiological situation.**
