



REQUIREMENTS FOR AWARDING THE CREDITS IN THE MEDICAL BIOPHYSICS STUDY PROGRAM: GENERAL MEDICINE



- 1. An active attendance at all practical sessions and seminars in Medical Biophysics is compulsory. If the teacher finds out that the student is not ready for the practical session, the teacher has the right to ask student for the substitution of the practical session.** Students are allowed to substitute the practical session (missed for serious reason) during the same week with other group. **Just two practical sessions are permitted for substitution during the compensatory week. Substitution of more than two practical sessions is possible only after permission of the head of institute and are extra payed.** The practical sessions during Rector's and Dean's free Days and National holidays are neither performed, substitution is on voluntary basis.
- 2. Successful completion of the practical session.** Evaluation of protocols by the teacher: **0 - 10 points.**
A fulfilment of the oral discussions at practicals (short questions related to individual tasks of the practical evaluated by the teacher): **0 - 10 points.**
- 3. Attendance at seminar with credit test and the analysis of test questions at the end of semester. Working-out the credit test by students according to the timetable. Test evaluation (the number of points is assigned as the second power of number of correct answers – 1 question consists of 3 individual statements) : 0 correct answers means $0 \times 0 = 0$ points, 1 correct answer means $1 \times 1 = 1$ point, 2 correct answers means $2 \times 2 = 4$ points ... 20 correct answers means $20 \times 20 = 400$ points.**

Expected rank according to the points sum:

A \geq 450, B \geq 390, C \geq 330, D \geq 270, E \geq 210, Fx $<$ 210

THE FINAL EXAM FOR MEDICAL BIOPHYSICS

- 1. Before being admitted to the final oral examination a candidate must carry out the Credit test.** The test is performed during last seminar at the end of semester according to the timetable. Substitution term for the test will be announced at the beginning of January. **The test is considered to be a part of the final exam.**
- 2. The terms of the oral examination will be published before the beginning of the exam period.**
- 3. Both the test and exam questions for Medical Biophysics are published at the web site of the Institute of Medical Biophysics.**
