### Notes:

Given time schedule is approximate. The exact timing of each activity can be changed according to teacher's duties, but can be adjusted according to students' needs as well.

The schedule was adjusted (reduced) due to the COVID-19 pandemic. For the same reason, seminars (in grey) are optional, their implementation depends on the requirements of students.

Students have to record a separate course of disease for each patient daily, including brief data on subjective patient's feelings, objective findings (routinely heart, lung, legs), vital functions (BP, HR), treatment proposal, auxiliary and laboratory tests proposal. Each student has to hand in the sheets of course of disease at the secretariat on closing of the practice.

Individual tasks at care for in-stay patients mean direct involvement in patients admission, leaving reports preparation, case history formulation, ECG and X-ray description, participation in diagnostic and therapeutic procedures (biopsies, CT, MR, USG).

It is forbidden to bring the patients' files out of the ward.
